

The Diocesan Department for Education is committed to identifying, forming and developing leaders at all levels in our Catholic schools.

Courses are offered for aspiring deputy headteachers and aspiring middle leaders in primary and secondary schools. Some aspects are delivered in collaboration with our Catholic Education Trusts and St John Vianney School – Teaching School Hub. The ‘Growing Our Own Primary Leaders’ middle leaders course and the ‘Middle Leadership in a Catholic School’ one day course aim to identify and develop leadership talent and potential in teachers.

Applications will also be accepted from those in non-diocesan schools who are interested in teaching in a Catholic school.

A certificate will be issued on completion of each course and the achievement celebrated at the Education Mass.

It is a requirement for delegates to attend all sessions of their chosen programme to complete the course

GROWING OUR OWN PRIMARY LEADERS 2022-23

FOR ASPIRING AND CURRENT PRIMARY MIDDLE LEADERS

Growing Our Own Primary Leaders is a course developed in collaboration with St John Vianney School – Teaching School Hub. The aim of this course is to identify, develop and nurture middle leaders for our Catholic schools. The course consists of one face-to-face welcome session and four twilight sessions.

The course will include talks, workshops, the sharing of good practice, the planning and completion of a school-based improvement initiative, and the experience of applying for a middle leader position.

Growing Our Own Primary Leaders is aimed at those aspiring to be middle leaders and for current middle leaders who wish to become more effective in their role. Applications will also be accepted from those in non-diocesan schools who are interested in teaching in a Catholic school.
